

This free checklist was produced by The Scottish Ornithologists' Club to mark the publication of their major new book **The Birds of Scotland**.

In two full-colour A4 hardback volumes, containing some 1600 pages, this encyclopaedia of Scottish birds was written by 150 experts. All 509 species ever seen in Scotland are included, from the all-important breeding species and winter visitors to the regular migrants and one-off vagrants that combine to make the Scottish avifauna so varied. Illustrated with 900 first-class photographs and 1500 charts and maps, this landmark publication is a must for everyone with an interest in Scottish birds - from the casual naturalist to the professional ornithologist, and for visitor and resident alike.
